1.0. Strategic Plan

2.0. Mission

- Illumination - Bring out the best of people and situations.
- Inclusion - Engage with people to co-author the future.
- Inspiration - Awaken the creative spirit.
- Integrity - Make choices for the good of the whole.

3.0. Vision

Destination: Renewal is a shared vision:

The Director of Education shall ensure that the plan is reviewed annually. The achievement of these goals will be communicated to the Board of Trustees during meetings at least twice a year, and annually with our partners in education and the general public, in the Director's Annual Report.
