



Policy: Transportation

The Superior North Catholic District School Board commits to operational and fiscal effectiveness in all of its partnerships, based on Catholic values. In on-going efforts at increasing efficiency through greater cooperation, the Superior North Catholic District School Board, Superior-Greystone District School Board, le Conseil scolaire de district catholique des Aurores boréales and le Conseil scolaire du district du Grand-Nord de l'Ontario have formed the East of Thunder Bay Transportation Consortium (the "Consortium").

The Consortium is governed by a Board of Directors, which is composed of one representative of each of the above-mentioned School Boards.

The Consortium has established its own set of policies and operational procedures. As a member Board to the Consortium, the Superior North Catholic District School Board endorses the Consortium in conducting its own affairs for transportation of all students throughout our region.

Section 190(1) of the Education Act states: "A board may provide for a pupil who is enrolled in a school that the board operates transportation to and from the school that the pupil attends."

The Boards consider transportation to be a privilege and not a right, and as such, transportation may be revoked or the levels of service changed by the Board or Consortium at their discretion.
