Business Arising out of Minutes

New Business

1. **Student Attendance Presentation** - Colleen Sheriff

Colleen shared her Student Attendance Presentation. This presentation has also been shared with principals to view at school council meetings. This is one of the issues we are trying to focus on. Colleen reviewed the absences of students and their effect on their future education. This is based on 2015-2016 school year attendance data. We are trying to let parents know the importance of attendance. There is higher attendance noted in grades one and eight. Rima mentioned that the Ministry does not track JK/SK students but we will start tracking as it's important to show the importance of student attendance right from the beginning of school. Rima shared information on a program in Trillium that will include the reason a student is absent. This information can be used to track as to why students are absent. As part of the CODE initiative we have the "I'm Here" campaign to encourage students attendance. A video on I'm Here was also shared with attendees.

2. **Student Technology Presentation** - Sarah Clowes

Sarah has completed a year of service with our Board, so it was a good time to summarize her Technology role in improving technology within the board. Sarah showed a few robotic video clips on students and their robotic mechanisms. There was discussion with Val Auger on the possibility of having an engagement night for parents of students that live in Pays Platt. Colleen Sheriff and Sarah have offered to assist with this.

Sarah discussed the 4 goals of the TELT position in detail.

3. **PRIME Training** - Rima Mounayer

Rima gave an update on PRIME training as we have connected with Tom Boland, a Math Consultant, in helping our students in math. PRIME is an assessment concept which places students on a continuum and assists them in moving forward. One teacher representative from each school will be trained. The trained facilitator will return to their schools and train the other teachers. We will look at updating our math program, at our schools, and assess what programs we are using at the moment. Resources will be rolled out for next year.

- Purchase of robotic devices for parent use
- Timeline - early Fall or Spring
- Tara Patterson will review and sign the proposal
