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1.0 Policy Statement

3.3 Student Engagement & Community Connections

Students must be active participants in shaping their future. Student engagement involves the active participation of all students in sustainable environmental practices, a strong student voice in decision-making, and involvement in the school and community in meaningful ways.

3.4 Environmental Leadership

By exercising environmental responsibility in its operations, the Superior North Catholic District School Board can serve as a model of corporate citizenship for students and the broader community and can ensure coherence with the environmental messages conveyed by the curriculum.
