1.0 Policy Statement

- 1.1 The Superior North Catholic District School Board values:
 - 1.1.1 the presence of God in each person;
 - 1.1.2 an inclusive Catholic culture that instills compassion;
 - 1.1.3 hope, integrity, faithfulness, respect and self-worth;
 - 1.1.4 Catholic-based spiritual development; and student success.
- 1.2 It is the policy of the Superior North Catholic District School Board that no school-aged child should be denied access to education because of special health support needs during school hours.
- 1.3 In order to ensure the safety of students with life-threatening allergies and medical conditions, and in accordance with Sabrina's Law, 2005; and Ryan's Law 2015, P-ES 324, the Superior North Catholic District School Board will implement appropriate strategies to reduce the risk of exposure to anaphylactic causative agents for anaphylactic students and will develop individualized plans for anaphylactic students to provide immediate response in the event of an emergency.
