Policy: AWARD OF MERIT

Effective: May 10, 2004

The means will be established by the Board to annually grant an award of merit to recognize a staff person or persons, parent or community member who has contributed exemplary service in their demonstration of dedication and/or support to Catholic Education in their community or in the entire Board.

This annual award will be determined and presented, publicly.

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION

AWARD OF MERIT

- 1) Outstanding contribution is to be defined in general terms so as to allow this recognition to be interpreted broadly and eligible for all members of the staff.
- 2) The recommendation for this annual award will be forwarded to the Board through an ad hoc committee.
- 3) The committee who will decide the appropriate recipient for the award of merit will be comprised of the Chair of the Board, or designate, and at least, two additional Trustees.
- 4) The committee will use its own judgement in determining the means by which nominations for the award will be received.
- 5) One nomination only may be recommended in any one year.
- 6) The award will be presented during an appropriate board event as recommended by the committee.
- 7) The Board's annual budget will provide the cost associated with the granting of this award.
