Policy: COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOLS

Effective: June 22, 2011

Policy Statement:

The Superior North Catholic District School Board encourages the community use of school buildings and playgrounds, where it does not interfere with school curricular and extra-curricular activities, with cleaning schedules, with repair schedules, or with other activities deemed by the Board to have priority.

It is the intent to have Board facilities used in the best interests of the community, when they are not required for school use. This is intended to be implemented in a cost neutral manner.

As long as specific grants targeted for community use of schools are provided, non-profit groups may have their fees reduced.

The Superior North Catholic District School Board has a Community Outreach Coordinator who is responsible for managing the use of schools after hours.
