Policy: SAFE ARRIVAL**Effective: April, 1999**

The Superior North Catholic District School Board will foster and maintain a safe environment for its students through implementation of effective measures, based on Catholic values, to ensure the safe arrival of all its students.

All members of our school system will be secure in the knowledge that we work and live in a school community that fosters concern, commitment and service to one another. All stakeholders have a role to play in ensuring the safety of students. These roles are clearly defined and communicated to all those concerned.

Parents and guardians are responsible for their children's safety. This safe arrival policy and procedure is a mechanism that parents and schools shall use to account for any pupil's unexplained failure to arrive at school.

The faith environment of our schools provides a basis for the development of genuine Christian values in our students. It is in the example of Jesus upon which we base our ideas on values, discipline, behaviour and response.
