

Policy: VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

Effective: October 19, 2011

Belief Statement:

The Superior North Catholic District School Board will foster and maintain a safe environment for its students and staff through the implementation of effective measures, based on Catholic values, to optimize their well-being.

Policy Statement:

Surveillance equipment may be installed to comply with safety requirements, as set out in the Education Act. Within the Superior North Catholic District School Board, surveillance equipment may be installed at some or all of our schools. Video surveillance and the resulting records may be used for inquiries and proceedings related to maintaining the health, welfare and safety of students, staff, and visitors while on School Board property, and for the purpose of protecting school property against theft or vandalism.

School boards in Ontario are subject to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, (the Municipal Act). This Act imposes obligations on institutions with respect to the collection, use, disclosure, access, retention, security and disposal of personal information.
