# **Business Arising Out of Minutes**

## **Professional Learning Update**

1. Literacy Resources to close gaps: <u>Lexia Core 5</u> and <u>Lexia: Power Up</u>

K. Desjardins shared video promotions for these literacy resources that have been purchased and are being used in all schools for students in Grades K to 8. These programs will address individual student needs.

Lexia Core 5 - This program is for Kindergarten to Grade 5 students and looks at individual student needs, tailoring programs and lessons to meet these needs. Lexia: Power Up is a program for students in Grades 6-8, where students are challenged to take ownership of their learning, at their own pace.

K. Desjardins shared the 2 videos with the committee. A license has been purchased for all students.

## **New Business**

1. Mental Health Update - Tracy Bryson

Mental Health First Aid First Nations training with Kristine Baccart provided a session at St. Joseph School on January 4, 2023, for all staff. We are still actively recruiting for a child and youth worker for this area. Our positive behavior support worker from Nipigon has returned. We are still partnering with Children's Centre in Thunder Bay. We have added a second Social Worker.

2. SIP Claim Applications for 2022-2023

SIP applications were submitted on time on January 6, 2023 to the Ministry of Education Regional office in Thunder Bay. Applications for 13 students were submitted. If approved, our funding for Special Education will increase.
