- 2021/2022 BAP Discussion <u>IEAC Board Action Plan 2021/22 Year</u>
   The Board Action Plan was shared with IEAC members.
- 2022/2023 Considerations and Input
   Various student projects were discussed and are being considered for our students.

IEAC considerations for 2022-23 were discussed with the group:

- During Treaty Week:
  - Have community come into the schools to share about Treaties and their impact to the local area
  - Similar to a science fair have students present different Treaties or information on Treaties to other students.
- Have the class make a wampum belt respecting that it is a Sacred Item
- Connecting with local communities and participate in harvesting and meat processing
- Have Students participate in drafting an Orange Shirt logo for the 2022/2023 school year Orange Shirt Day
- Hold a Cedar tree planting at each school (using wild cedar trees)
  - Invite community members, Elders and have them help with the planning
  - Honour the 4 directions, animals, medicines...
  - Involve youth drum to the trees maybe use the honour song
  - Teacher survey what resource would you like to use? What PD could we offer to support your learning? Refresher?
  - More land-based learning hide preparation (around the 4 seasons and 13

moons)

- Bear grease teaching
- Student teaching
- Incorporate and collaborate with community and schools for September 30th - plan early so that we can collaborate together - NO PD Day on this important date
- Ojibwe prayer and song incorporated in prayer services and masses
- Feast the drums in our schools
- Knowledge Keeper and Elders willing to help our schools
- Resources sent to our schools should be distributed to all staff/students at the specific schools as opposed to sending information only to the NSL teacher.

#### 4. SNCDSB Indigenous Professional Development Day

This year's Indigenous PD Day will be held on April 21, 2023. We are in the early stages of planning and welcome your feedback and input in preparation for this day. We would like a system wide PD in person event. We will establish a sub-committee to assist with the planning for this day.
