A letter created for families in our communities impacted by the mill's closure was shared with the Trustees. This letter shares supports that are available to reduce the risk of negative mental health and/or family crisis. This letter has been shared with the families of the school Principals.

Kindergarten Registration begins on January 15th. The promotion has begun on both board and school social media and in the communities through posters, postcards, mailouts, and radio interviews with early childhood educators, superintendents, teachers, and principals. 360 pictures of our Kindergarten spaces will be taken to add to our website. This will allow families to see exactly what our Kindergarten classrooms will look like.

Emma Hamilton will be the new Child and Youth Worker for the Schreiber and Terrace Bay area.

ii. <u>Rima Mounayer, Superintendent of Education Monthly Report</u>

Math Plan focuses on teaching students through fun and engaging activities that the whole school can participate in. You can see how excited the children are when they are participating. We are in the second phase of the math plan. During the second audit task, we will look at data and then work with every classroom teacher and principal to see where we are. Karly Baker is back with our math team.

Collaborating with Confederation College to create a program similar to the Lakehead University program but for students up north who may be interested in a college program. This would be for students in grades four and up.

iii. Paul Tsekouras, Superintendent of Education Monthly Report

This month, the Technology Enabled Learning Teacher (TELT) is offering training for teachers and students to add artifacts to their portfolios, this will help them choose a pathway to support their future learning. They will be using this learning in the parent-teacher conferences coming up.



Received a new Board School Identification Database (BSID) number for our virtual school. We can now offer our grade eight students a secondary credit as a pilot project.

Advent celebrations throughout our schools were highlighted in <u>Edition 3 of the Superior</u> North Catholic District School Board #Highlights newsletter.

This information provided in the Halo is very helpful to our staff in our schools.

iv. Chris Martin, Assistant Superintendent of Education Monthly Report

Shared space meetings will be starting at each of our schools that share a facility with the Conseil scolaire de district catholique de Aurores boreales and EarlyOn centres this month. This will provide a platform to establish stronger relations and establishing shared efficient routines.

Continued learning about Artificial Intelligence (AI) and the lack of governance around the world around this technology, and we will be proactive to ensure we protect our staff and students with AI. A policy will be created. Our Technology Enabled Learning Teacher (TELT) is looking at different AI technologies that can be used with our students.

One to two individuals per school were trained in Occupational Health and Safety Certification training.

d. Indigenous Education

The elders' council meeting will take place at the end of this month, and the Education Service Agreement partners will be invited to this meeting.

e. Finance

i. <u>George Scott, Manager of Finance Monthly Report</u>

Revised Estimates have been completed and submitted to the Ministry. These were submitted with a projected surplus of \$82k based on increased enrolment and some staffing changes.

The audit committee approved two two-year audit plans in the last audit meeting in December 2023. In the 2023-2024 School Year, we will be audited on Facility Procurement and Student Health, Safety and Well-Being. For 2024-2025, we will be

These audits have been selected based on the results of a Risk Assessment exercise undertaken by the Senior Team and Managers. Trustee Monks has once again been elected as the Chair of the Audit Committee. The next audit meeting will be scheduled in March.

Updates to old servers to enhance security have been completed. We are looking to upgrade the video cameras at our facilities. These cameras could assist in preventing vaping inside our schools.

Handrails were installed at St. Joseph Catholic School, have positively impacted the student and his family and show the teamwork of all our departments.

All doors presently have FOB access, and the next phase is to change exterior locks and will be FOB-only access for anyone besides Principals of the building.
