1.0 Policy

- 1.0 The Superior North Catholic District School Board will adopt a comprehensive crisis response for the Board and for each school in the system, consisting of the following:
 - 1.1.1 School Crisis Response Incident Planning
 - 1.1.2 Threat Response
 - 1.1.3 Critical Incident Plan
 - 1.1.4 Crisis Intervention Plan
- 1.2 The Superior North Catholic District School Board has a commitment and responsibility to ensure the safety of all students and staff inside Board buildings and on Board property. The possibility of a major violent incident is a reality of today's society. These policies and procedures provide direct support to our schools in the management of a crisis situation. These supports have been developed through consultation with the Ontario Provincial Police.
- 1.3 This policy will provide the support action in a manner that is consistent with Superior North Catholic District School Board's Mission, Vision and Values Statement, while respecting the increasing diversity of our community.
